Terry Lilley is a marine biologist with over 5000 hours logged working underwater. He has proof that alluvial mud from illegal work on the river is killing the reef. In the photo above he is showing where he got a staph infection from diving at the mouth of the river. Broken berms, cesspools, and illegal dredging has put reefs in the "first stage of cancer". The build up of polluted mud at the river mouth is growing so fast that it will dam up the river and you will be able to walk to Lumahai in the next several years if nothing is done about it.
