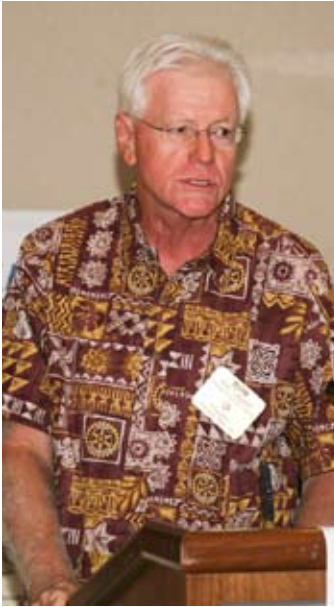
A new voice for Kauai

2nd woman: How horrible!

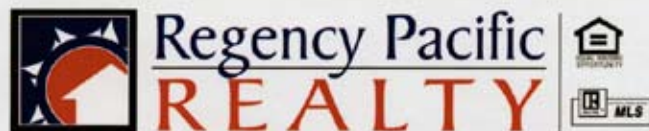
1st woman: It wasn't so bad. After I quit shaking from the cold, I began to get warm & sleepy, and finally died a peaceful death. What about you?
