Sally gave us a run down of the changes to The Real Property Assessments for 2012-2013. There are many significant changes to eliminate loopholes for people who are not paying their fair share and other changes to provide tax relief for people who qualify. Getting anyone to agree about how to accomplish that is a challenge to say the very least. One example of the changes is that qualifying homeowners can apply for an \$120,000 additional exemption if their income does not exceed \$56,400 per year. (Many restrictions do apply) Sally said information is available about the changes and encourages you to talk to the assessment department for additional information.
