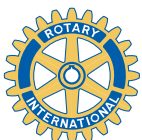

Naliko Markel's business card describes his title as the Minister of the Interior of the Kingdom of Hawaii. He presented information in his talk, and in a press kit that he said has the information to understand the process of recognition of the reinstated Hawaiian Kingdom and the inherent Sovereignty of Hawaii. In a low key presentation he avoided being confrontational by presenting documentation to support his arguments. His conclusions are not recognized by the U.S. Government at this time, however the public apology by president Bill Clinton and the U.S. Congress in 1993 for the overthrow of the Hawaiian kingdom has been cornerstone in the effort for the worldwide recognition of their claim.
