Ronnie Walker talked about what happens to the people left behind when there is a suicide in the family or by a close friend. She uses the term Suicide survivor to describe the people a suicide leaves behind. The shock of losing a loved one to suicide often has the following symptoms. The following symptoms are similar to the ones people suffer with post traumatic stress, Bad memories, flash backs, emotional numbness, feeling detached, irritable, angry, depressed and guilty. In the US there are 35,000 suicides a year. Washington D.C. leads the list, with New York, Massachusetts, And New jersey right behind. Hawaii is 9th on the list. 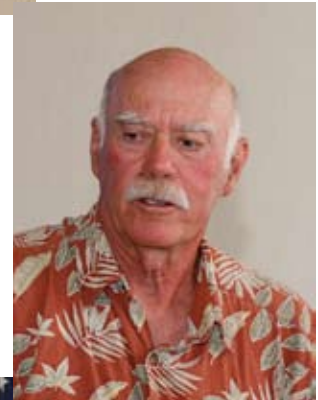
