You are going to pay more for water



The Kauai Department of Water manager, David Craddick said the price of water was going up. Some of the pipes were put in the ground back in the 20's. The 2001, 20 year plan to upgrade the system ran out of money 10 years later. The cost of borrowing more money for repairs is not practical. The only possible alternative is to raise rates. Currently, there are two prices for water, Residential and Agricultural. No distinctions are made for commercial properties. One way to help find a fair balance is to increase the Facilities Reserve Charge, which is the fee new customers pay to hook into the system. Right now the fee is based on the size of the water pump. The Department of water is interested in public input and if you have a comment you can contact them at 245-5461. The price of water is definitely going up, the only question now is how will it be structured to be as fair to everyone as possible.
