Jonathan Mcroberts made a provocative presentation that challenged the status quo regarding the "War on Drugs." He pointed out that the U.S. has spent over one Trillion dollar over the last 40 years fighting the War on Drugs" but the addiction rate remains the same and drugs are easily available to anyone who can afford them. He also pointed out the harm drug prohibition in the US has caused throughout the world. It is leading to the corruption of police forces and governments world wide and so far has accounted for over 35,000 deaths in Mexico alone. 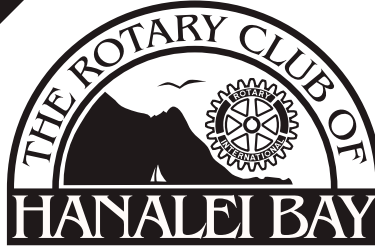


