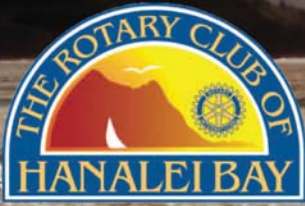

Dr. Jim Maragos



Dr. Jim Maragos is widely recognized as one of our nations leading coral reef experts. He was the 2010 recipient of the U. S. Fish and Wildlife Services 'Rachel Carson' award for scientific excellence. Dr. Maragos pioneering work helped lead the way to the establishment of four marine national monuments, providing the largest span of protected marine ecosystems in the world. He began his groundbreaking work with his doctoral thesis, which focused on assessing the impacts of sewage on corals in Kaneohe Bay. This research helped compel local governments to remove the sewage outfalls from the bay and led to coral recovery. This seminal project is recognized as one of the first successful habit restoration projects for coral reefs and helped introduce the discipline of coral reef management to the world.

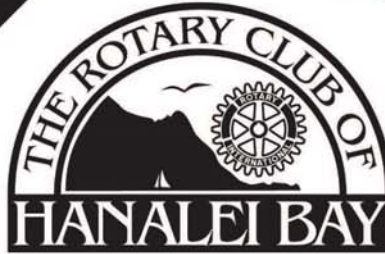
