Robin Thompson had an unhappy buck because her husband was going out of town.

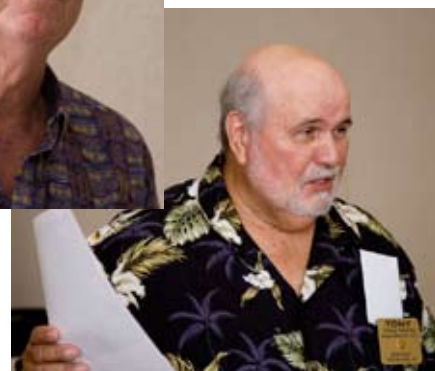
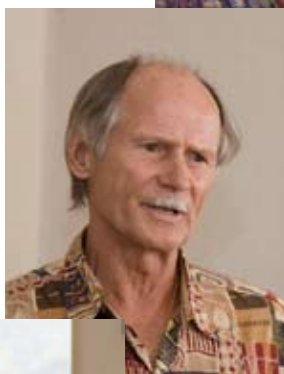


Sunny Bunyan talked about a cancer benefit in Kilauea
