Tom Lodico talks about RHYLA



Tom Lodico visited the Rotary Club of Hanalei Bay to bring us up to date on this years RHYLA camp. The Rotary Youth Leadership Awards has been held in Kokee for the past five years and this time it will be moved just outside Hanalei at Camp Waipa. Tom is still looking for volunteers with vans to transport kids, adults who can help cook and manage the camp, and a big tent for the kids to sleep in. This year there will be 25 kids participating with 3 of them being Rotary International Students, 19 of the kids will be part of Leadership Kauai. This year will have a mentor that will explain and demonstrate ancient Hawaiian trapping techniques, a confidence building rope course and a study on ethics using the four way test as an example.

RHYLA has been a proven way to give kids that have not lived up to their leadership potential a chance to bloom. Tom talked about several kids who had their lives changed in positive ways because of the experience. One went on to become student at a school for high end auto engineering. Another was accepted at Annapolis. Rotary International states the goals of the camp as an opportunity to:

- Demonstrate Rotary's respect and concern for youth
- Provide an effective training experience for selected youth and potential leaders
- Encourage leadership of youth by youth
- Recognize publicly young people who are rendering service to their communities

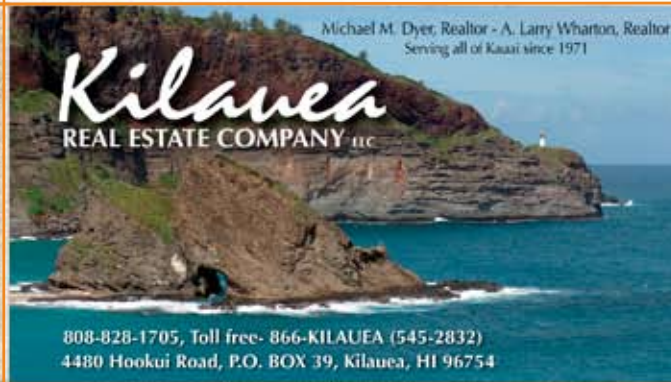
