Through a generous grant they have been able to start a grass roots effort to create initiatives with the idea of creating sustainability in many area. You can hear more about their efforts on KCCR where they talk to local and international experts about how to create and maintain sustainability. Bimonthly on Fridays at noon on KCCR, 91.9 FM

Malama Kauai’s prime concerns include food, energy self sufficiency, economic security, intelligent growth, preservation and protection of the environment, strengthening community engagement and perpetuation of Native Hawaiian and other island cultures. They have helped spearhead the “Keep it Local” campaign to promote local goods, agriculture and services. Money spent for local products and services stays in Kauai.

They are involved in creating community workshops where people in the community can learn more about water catchment, solar power, waste management,

growing your own vegetables and creating a zero waste home.

They are also active in building partnerships with other groups with similar interests. Some of the groups are Apollo Kauai, Zero Waste Kauai, Sierra Club, Save

Koke’e Surfrider Foundation and other responsible groups.

Supporting local agriculture includes protecting critical water systems, advocacy to preserve important agricultural lands, support for garden initiatives.
