Tsajon von Lixfeld shows us how we can help the victims in Mynamar



Past president Tsajon von Lixfeld has close ties in the east from tavleing in his youth and through his business contacts and friends. The tragedy in Mynamar has been compounded by the governments refusal to allow outside help. The effects of the second worse cyclone in southeast Asia has left five million people displaced, 130,000 people dead and another 60,000 people unaccounted for. It is estimated that there is ten billion dollars in damage.



Tsajon made a telling presentation that showed the efforts of one of his friends there that has been able to do some good. Anton Ferwerda has been buying food and emergency supplies to the people that need it most. He has done what he can with the resources he has and now is asking for help and contributions so he can continue. The government is in effect taking an 18% cut of any money contributed through conventional channels. Anton is able to get 100% of the money donated through him to the people. All highways out of the state say: 'Go back'.

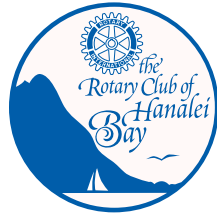

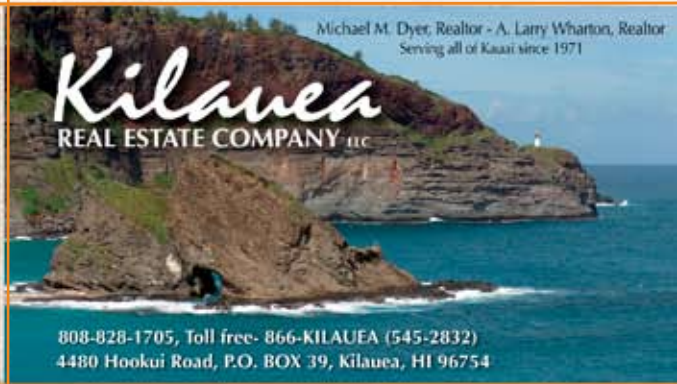
