She pointed out that the incoming president Jeff Goodman had an article about him in the Reader's Digest. Jeff said he was pleased at how it was written.

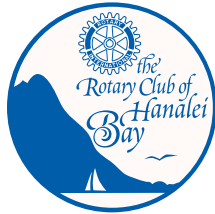
She also expressed a desire that Jonathan McRoberts filled George Corrigan's Rotary humor spot with jokes SHE found funny.

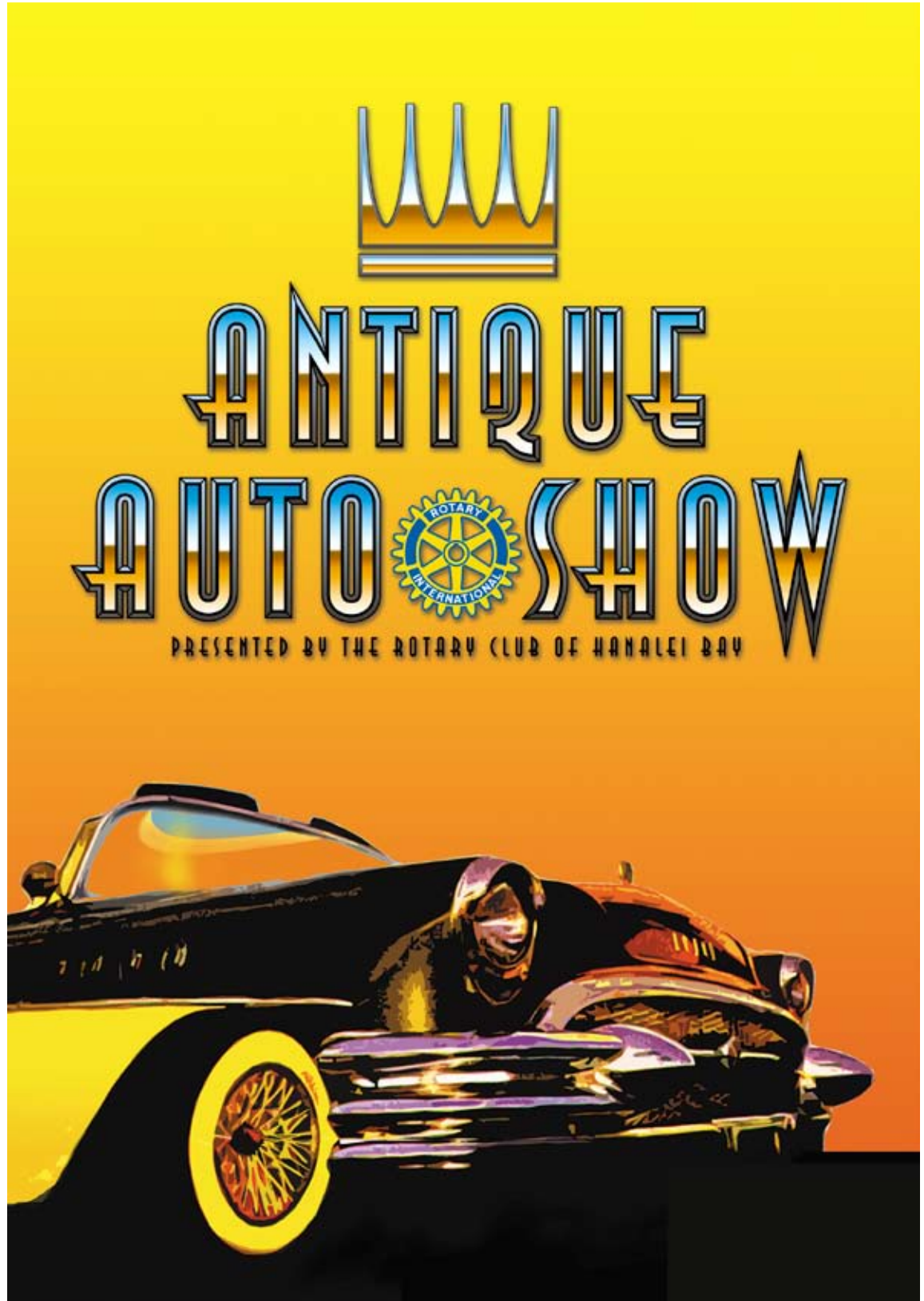

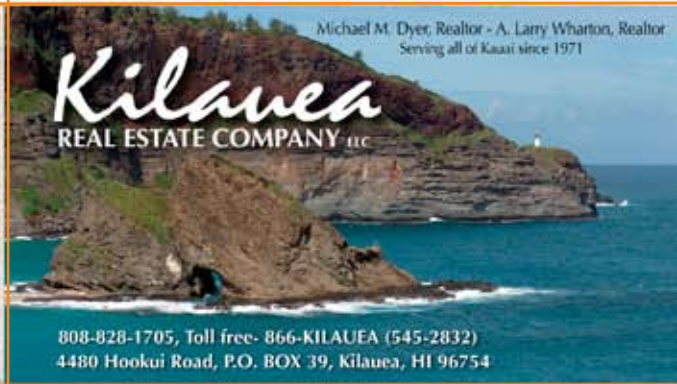
